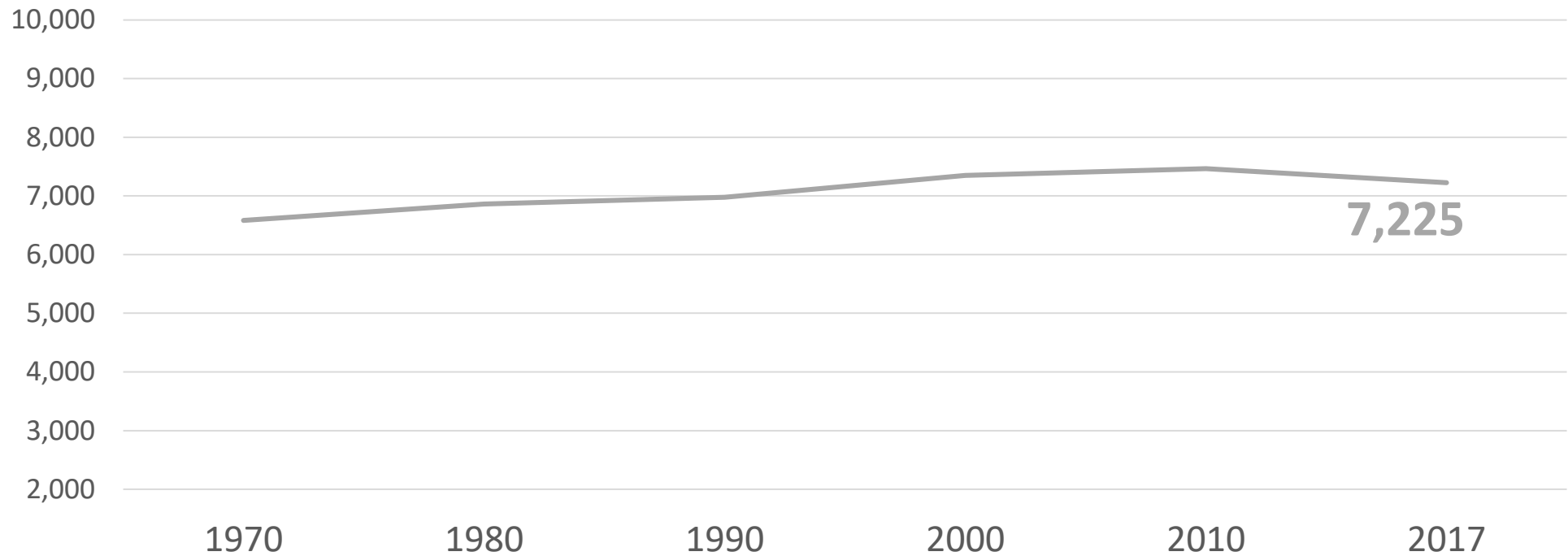

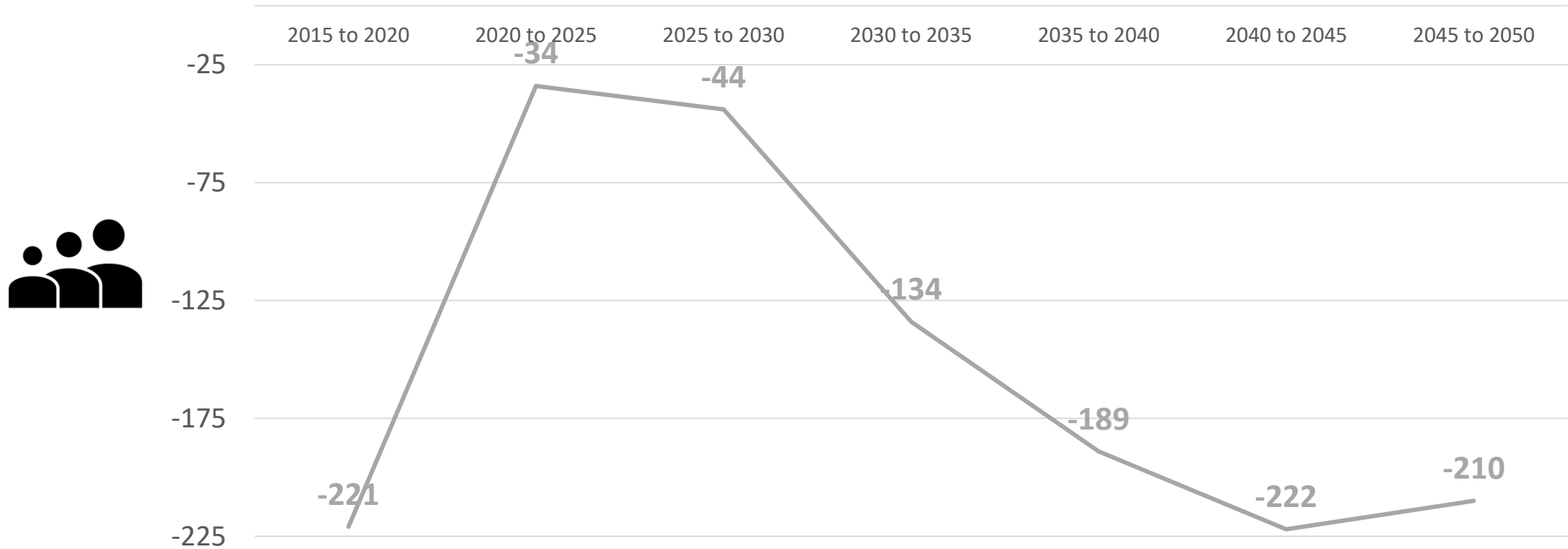
County Population Over Time

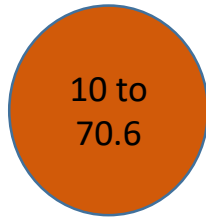

Statewide Population Projections

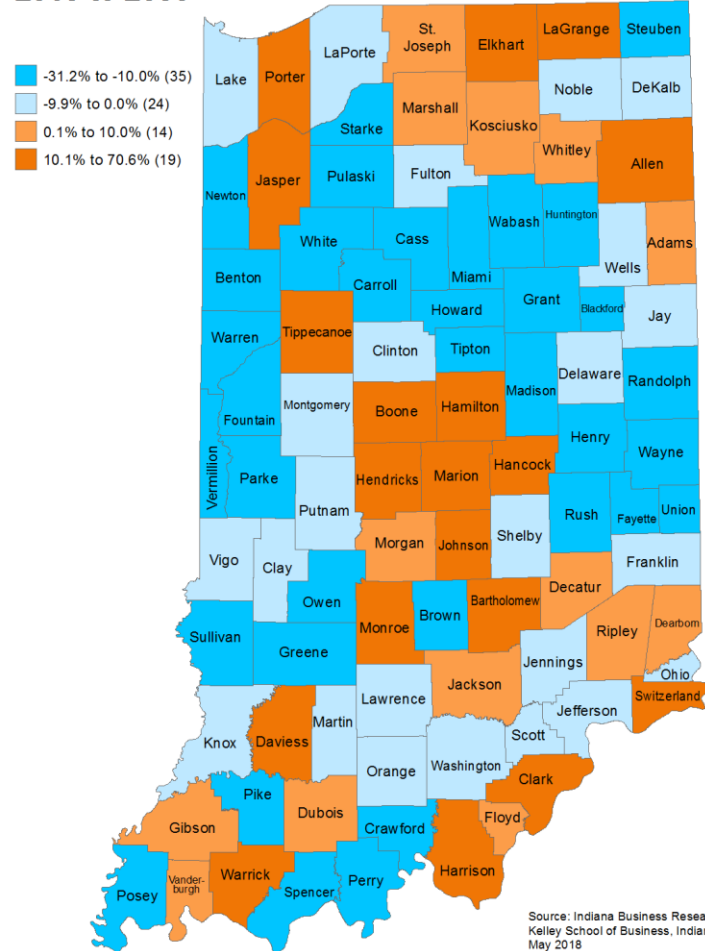

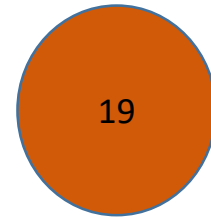
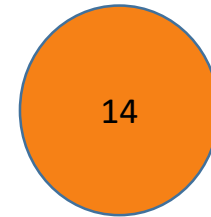
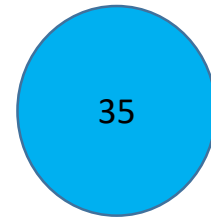
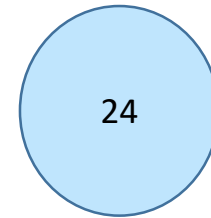


Population Projections

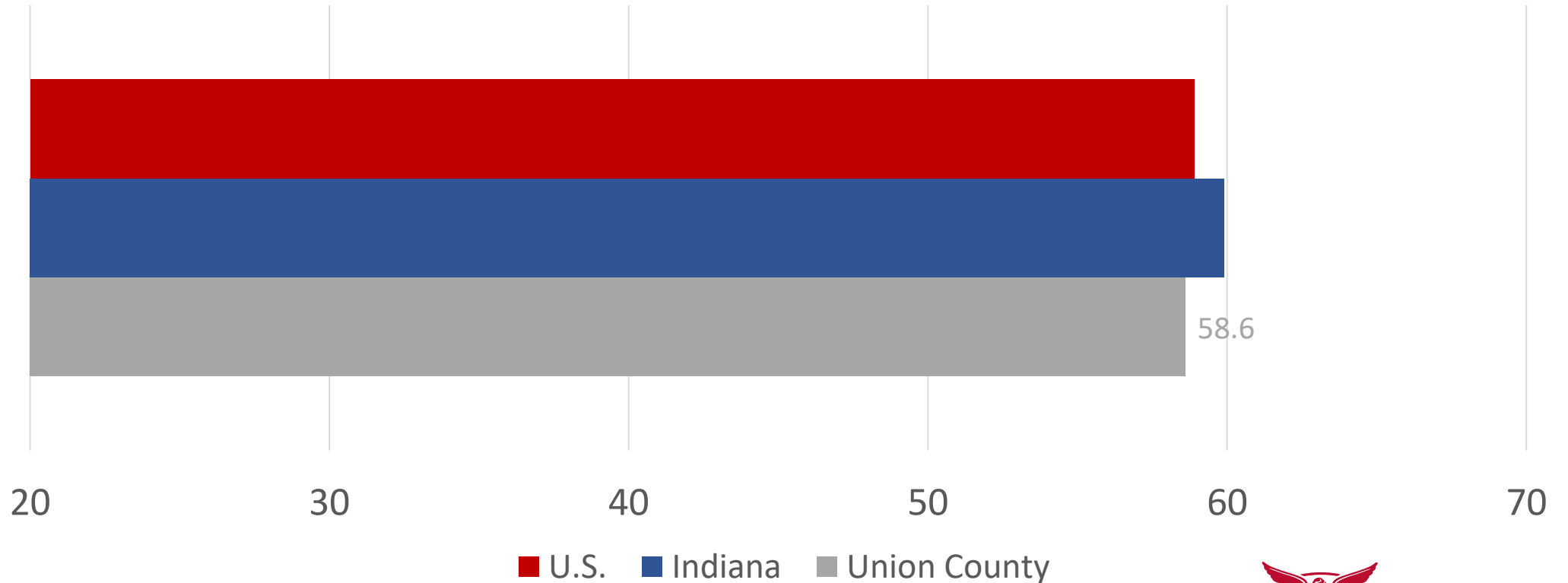

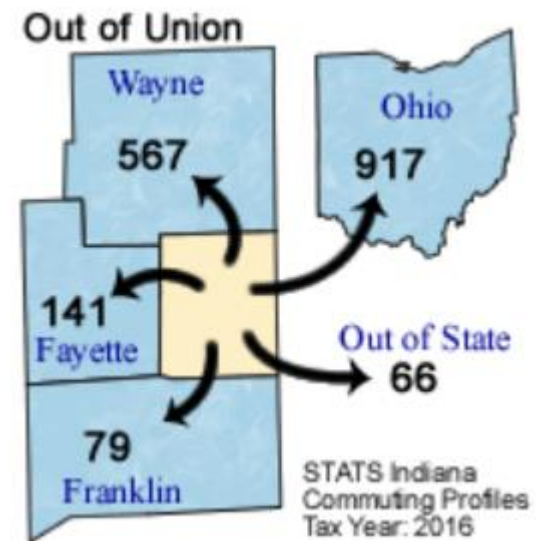
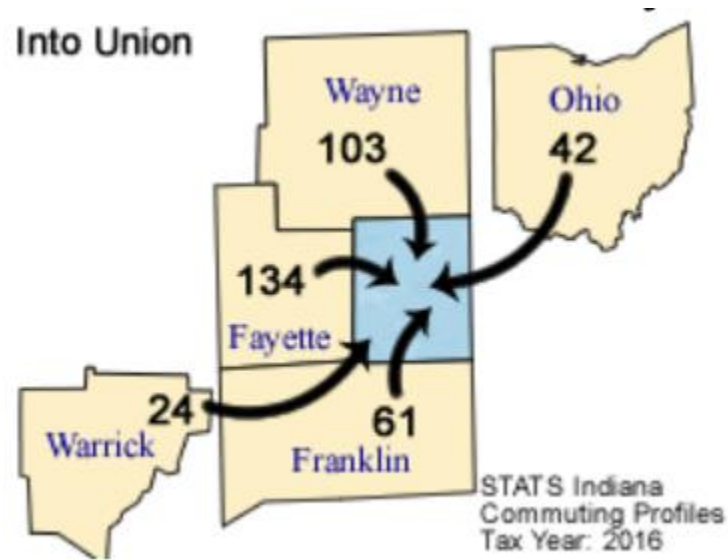

2017 Total # of People Employed/Total # of People Working Age (%)

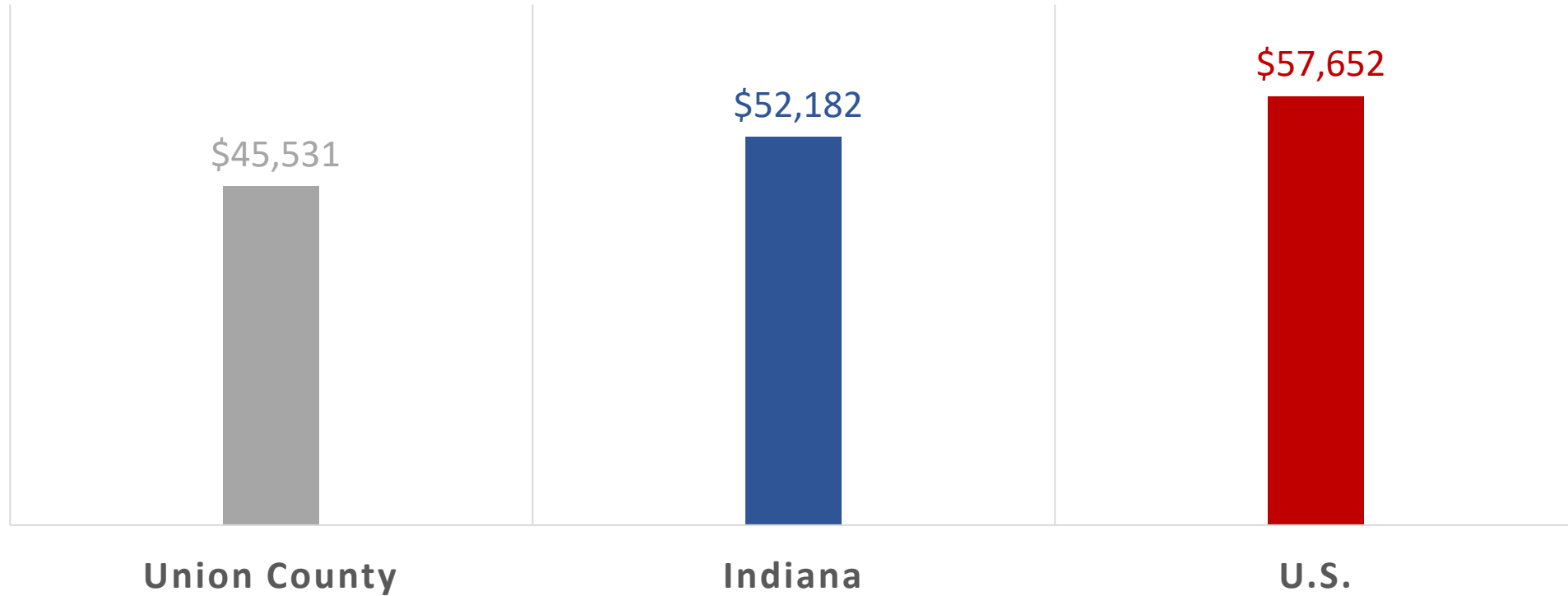


Commuting Patterns



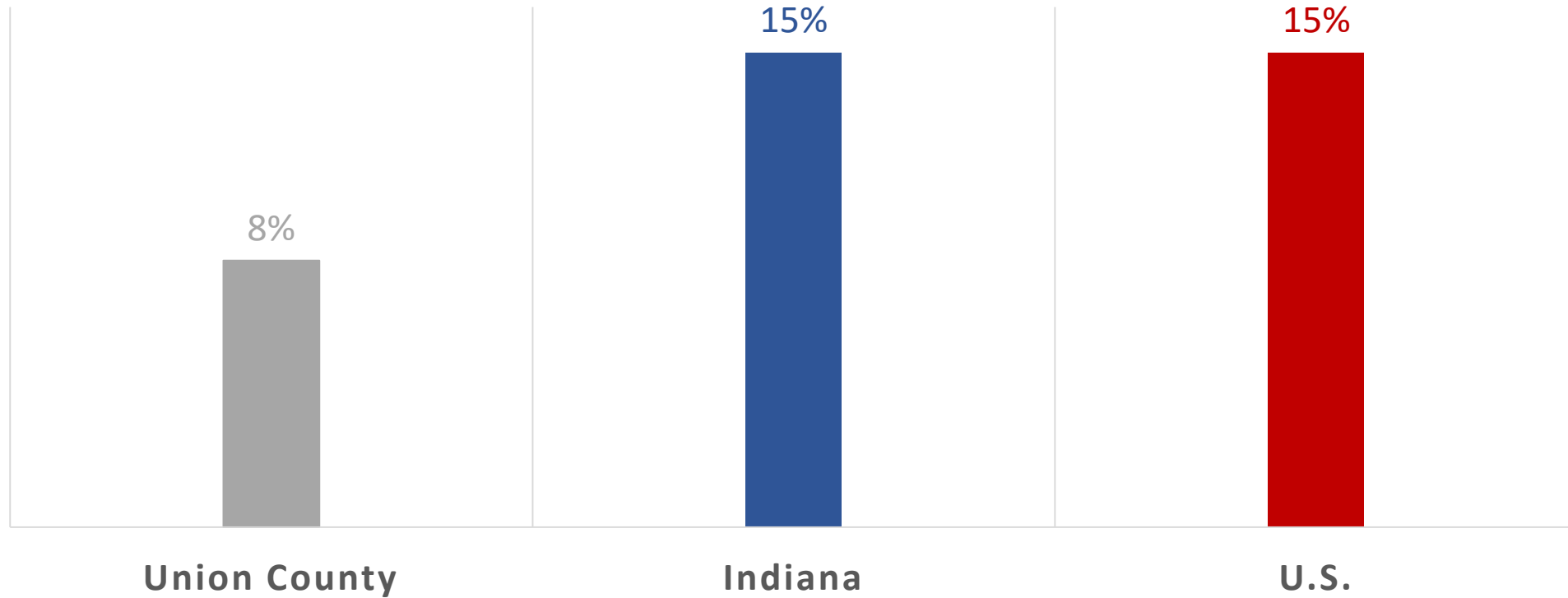
HH Median Income
